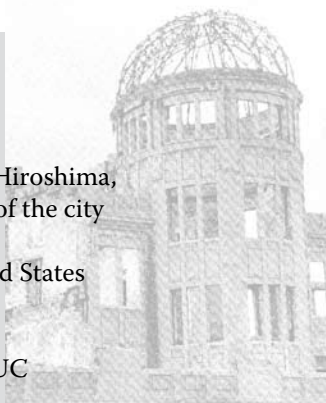
special visit by Takashi Teramoto
